Dependent Students

For a dependent student to be considered an Illinois resident in order to receive a scholarship and/or grant:

- the parent who is required to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) must physically reside in Illinois and Illinois must be his/her true, fixed, and permanent home at the time the initial FAFSA was completed and processed by the Central Processing System (CPS);
- or if Illinois becomes the parent's true, fixed, and permanent home after the initial FAFSA is filed, the student's and the parent's state of legal residence and permanent mailing address must be corrected to indicate Illinois on the Student Aid Report (SAR)/Institutional Student Information Record (ISIR). The corrections must be received by the Illinois Student Admission Commission (ISAC) while data is still accepted and processed for the applicable academic year.

Independent Students

For an independent student to be considered a resident of Illinois s/he must have physically resided in Illinois for 12 continuous full months immediately prior to the start of the academic year for which assistance is requested and Illinois must be his/her true, fixed, and permanent home

Independent Students

Parents of dependent students can submit any document listed below as long as it shows proof of residency for at least one day between September 03, 2022 to September 04, 2023.
