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Your Loan Debt

Students are obligated to repay student loans borrowed to pay for this program, including interest. Loan Nonpayment Statistics

Massachusetts requires institutions to disclose a loan nonpayment percentage. The Massachusetts loan nonpayment percentage includes those students that were not required to make payments because they continued their studies, were active in the U.S. military, were physically disabled or qualified for deferral or forbearance or under other terms as established by the U.S. Department of Education. The Massachusetts nonpayment figure for Chamberlain University is 87.1 percent.

The official three-year federal cohort default rate for all institutions in 2018 was 7.3 percent. For Chamberlain University that rate was 2.6 percent.

Placement Rates and Employment Statistics

Massachusetts law requires schools to disclose graduate placement rates and employment statistics. Chamberlain University gathers graduate employment information through a variety of means. Generally, the information is gathered from forms graduates complete and sign electronically. Chamberlain University also may collect data through in-person, telephone, or email interviews with graduates or from third-party sources. However, Chamberlain University neither verifies with employers nor guarantees the accuracy of information gathered. Because Chamberlain University does not verify employment data with employers and instead relies on the information gathered, for the purpose of this disclosure, Chamberlain University discloses a graduate placement rate and total placement rate of zero percent for all programs.

Chamberlain University provides career and employment seeking advising and assistance. The use of the term "Placement" here does not imply that Chamberlain University places students with employers at the conclusion of their studies.
